Introduction: Rewards Encourage People

- Survey Data: Performance improves significantly when rewards are given (up to +44%)
- Effect of words of gratitude and praise (+88.8%)
- Believers are also promised "a life with rewards"

Review of the Previous Message

- Problem in the Corinthian church: factions, jealousy, strife = "people of the flesh"
- They were spiritually immature, like infants

1) The Roles of Apollos and Paul: The Lord Gives the Reward

- Servants = "deacon" / "waiter"
- Growth comes not from people, but from the Lord (vv.6–7)
- The source of spiritual growth is the work of the Lord
- Preachers are fellow workers for the Lord (vv.8–9)
- The Lord gives a reward according to each one's labor

Application:

- Do not depend too much on charismatic preachers or YouTube pastors
- Trust not in people, but in God the Lord

2) Cautions for Receiving Rewards (vv.10-15)

- 1 Christ Alone Is the Only Foundation (vv.10-11)
- Foundation = Jesus Christ alone
- Grace already given, completed (Aorist tense)

(2) Building Materials = Fruits of Life (vv.12-15)

- "Gold, silver, precious stones" = won't burn, valuable
- "Wood, hay, straw" = burns, worthless
- The "fire of the Lord" will test each one's work
- If the building remains, there is reward; if burned, there is loss (salvation is not lost)

What is valuable?

• Fruit of the Spirit, faith, humility, obedient practice

What is worthless?

• Hypocrisy, pride, loveless actions, faith for appearance

Related Image:

- Parable of Jesus: House built on the rock vs. house built on the sand
- \rightarrow The one who hears and acts remains; the one who only hears collapses
